Dropping Off/Pick Up of Students

Before and after school are always busy times at our drop off/pick up zones at school. For parents who use the Church Road Gate please ensure that you accompany your child across the road. Staff have noticed that some children are crossing the road without having a parent walking next to them. It is important that parents collect their child from inside the school grounds.

For parents who use the school bus/car park zone please accompany your child at all times. Children are not to walk across this area without parents. The drop off zone is designed for continuous flow of vehicles and as such it is NOT a parking zone. Parents using this zone need to ensure they move forward and do not stop at the entry point. Cars are banking up in this area, this stops the flow of traffic.

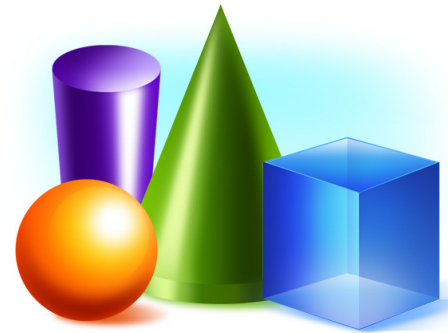

Grade 2/3 Preview

Next week will be a week of reflection and preparation as we get ready for our first student led interviews. Students will spend time reflecting on their strengths as learners, what they have achieved so far this year, and their goals for the coming semester. They will prepare a presentation, along with supporting evidence to show parents at the interviews. Please refer to the information provided in the newsletter, along with the video link, so that you can get a feel for what student led interviews

are like. We are really looking forward to participating in the process, and hope to see you all on either the 27th or 28th of June.

In Maths, we will continue to explore 3D shapes and multiplication. To support your child, you could ask them to find 3D shapes in the environment, and try to count how many edges, faces and vertices (corners) they have. Following are a couple of links to videos that students could view:

Students will be uploading a video to Seesaw of themselves reading a rhyming poem this week, or early next week. They will then bring the poem home to practise. The purpose is for them to practise reading the poem with good fluency, phrasing and expression, so that they improve their ability to read poems. Please make some time to listen to your child read their poem and provide them with feedback on what they are doing well, and what they can improve on – for example “You read all the words clearly. Next time try to slow down a little and pause at the end of each line”.
