Our students have accepted this personal reading challenge discovering new authors, genres and writing styles. The Challenge will finish at the end of August, so there is still plenty of reading time for students to add to their lists of completed books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and can choose to have their name included on the online Honour Roll. A signed consent form is needed for student's names to appear on the online Honour Roll and I will be sending these home in the next few weeks.
