## PRINCIPAL COMMENTS: PAUL JORGENSEN

I hope all have fared well through the difficult times presented to many by the recent Bushfire activity. The fires although not close to the school still have affected school activity, with buses suspended, family's homes close to fires, smoke around the school and many students absent from school.

For some children this can be a difficult time and cause concern and even trauma. The link below provides information that may support children and their families cope with crisis. During the smoke filled days and the days of extreme heat, if children are outside they are asked to play sedentary games or go to the library during lunchtime and recess. Children with known asthma concerns are asked to use their puffers or preventative medications and are monitored during the day. If Asthma plans are not current, up to date, or we do not have signed asthma plans from a doctor then

these children are not monitored as closely and are potentially at risk as staff are then unaware of their needs. It is the parents/carers responsibility to provide this information to school each year with an updated asthma plan.
