



Student Dress Code (Uniform Policy)

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Hazelwood North Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Hazelwood North Primary School's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual students whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- support Hazelwood North Primary School's commitment to ensuring that our students feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
- reduce student competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its students within the wider community.

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for students and is cost effective for families.

SCOPE

Students are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

UNIFORM AND APPEARANCE

The full list of Hazelwood North Primary School's school uniform item requirements are available at Appendix A to this policy.

General appearance

While at school, travelling to or from school or participating in school activities, Hazelwood North Primary School students must comply with the following:

- Uniforms must be clean and in good repair
- It is recommended that uniforms be clearly marked with the owner's name
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided these are not visible

Jewellery and cosmetics

Students are not permitted to wear decorative jewellery to school. Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears and watches, are the only acceptable jewellery. Digital and analogue watches are encouraged (refer to digital technology policy for smart watch guidelines).

Cosmetics may not be worn at school. Only simple nail polish is permitted (acrylic or stick on nails are not permitted).

Hair and Sun safety

Shoulder length or longer hair is to be tied back to help restrict the spread of nits and lice and for student safety.

School uniform hats must be worn outside from 1st September to 30th April and on any other day prescribed by the school. School uniform hats may also be worn outside of this time period, by parent or student choice.

Hats and beanies are not to be worn inside.

Students are permitted to wear sunglasses during outdoor activities. Sunglasses should be close-fitting, wrap-around that meet the Australian Standards 1067 and cover as much of the eye area as possible.

Second Hand Uniform

Hazelwood North Primary School also offers second hand uniform to be purchased for a \$2 donation per item to the school. Purchases can be made at the front office of the school.

Year 6

Year 6 Commemorative Rain Jackets and t-shirts are coordinated by the school and in conjunction with the provider during the term 4 prior for Year 6 students. Purchase arrangements are communicated to families at that time.

Support for families experiencing difficulty

IMPLEMENTATION

Hazelwood North Primary School will ensure that this Student Dress Code is communicated to all families and students through our website. We will assist students who may be experiencing difficulties complying with this policy where possible.

If a student is out of school uniform or otherwise breaches the Student Dress Code on a recurring basis, a note will be provided to the student and parents by the classroom teacher. If non-compliance with the dress code becomes a continued occurrence, the Principal will be informed and a phone call home may be required. In this event, the school will continue to work with the student and family to support compliance.

EXEMPTIONS TO STUDENT DRESS CODE

We recognise that there may be situations where the application of this dress code may affect students unequally.

Students and their parents or carers may apply either in writing or in person to the Principal for an exemption to this Student Dress Code if:

- an aspect of this code prevents the student from complying with a requirement of their religious, ethnic or cultural beliefs or background
- the student has a particular disability or health condition that requires a departure from the dress code
- the student or their parents/carers can demonstrate particular economic hardship that prevents them from complying with the dress code.

When the Principal receives a request for an exemption, they will:

- consider the grounds for the exemption request
- explain the process to the student and/or their parents/carers
- encourage the student and/or their parents/carers to support their application with evidence.

The Principal or delegate will then try to negotiate a resolution that is acceptable to all parties. If an exemption is not allowed, then written reasons will be provided to the student and/or their parents or carers.

APPENDIX A: HAZELWOOD NORTH PRIMARY SCHOOL UNIFORM ITEMS

All year round

The following items may be worn all year round:

Jackets/Rain coat (optional)

Navy blue spray jacket with school logo

Jumper or Vest

Navy blue polar fleece with school logo

Navy blue polar/vest fleece with school logo

Polo shirts

Navy blue or light blue long and short sleeved with school logo.

Shorts

Plain navy blue shorts without decoration or brand name.

Shorts must be loose fitting and mid-thigh or lower in length.

Pants

Plain, navy blue track pants without decoration or brand name

Skorts

Plain navy skorts without decoration or brand name and can be worn with navy blue tights/stockings. Skorts must be loose fitting and mid-thigh or lower in length.

Socks or tights/stockings

Navy blue or white socks

Navy blue tights/stockings

Footwear

Appropriate footwear is to be worn. Summer shoes with covered toes, black, navy or white school shoes or pull on school boots or runners are permitted. No thongs, open-toed sandals or crocs are permitted.

Headwear

Elastic Bands used to tie up hair may be worn in any colour.

Dresses

Summer blue and white checked dress

Hats – to be worn from 1st September to 30th April

Navy broadbrim without decoration or brand name.

Accessories

Art Smock – any colour
