- We are not allowed to block Church Road so if the pick up zone is full to the end of our car park, you will need to park across the road and wait for it to clear to come over, or walk across and collect your child.
- Students are only to get in and out of the car at the designated place near the bins, unless they/you have been given the go ahead from staff. Having cars pulling out of the line into the car park is causing safety concerns.

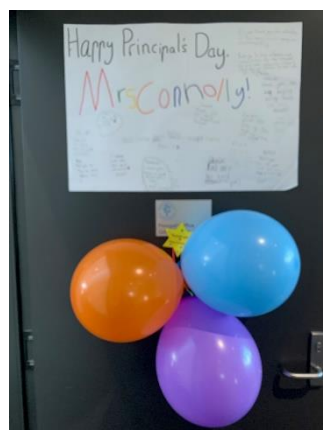
